### **BEEF SECTION - RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### **CHIEF STEWARD:**

General rules and regulations for the governance and conduct of the Franklin A & P Show shall be the same as the rules and regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (Inc) and it shall be deemed as if they have been printed in full in this Schedule. If any Exhibitor is not sure of the conditions he should get in touch with the Secretary. **The Society may publish the names of the winners.**

**OWNERSHIP:** All cattle must be the property of the Exhibitor or be a Leased animal with an official lease registered with the Breed society or the RAS. All cattle entered in the Breed Classes must be entered or eligible for registration in the recognised Herd Books of the affiliated breed societies. The Highland cattle section is open to **all** Highland Cattle entered or eligible for registration with the RAS affiliated Highland Cattle Societies and are registered on the RAS highland Show register. If the Show Register is not available at close off of entries, eligible entries will be determined by the RAS Liaison Committee. All cattle shall wear a catalogue number when parading in the ring for judging, but no animal shall wear an award ribbon or card awarded in a previous class while in the ring for judging in any special class or for the Championship awards. All cattle entered in group or special classes must be exhibited in open classes.

No badges or ribbons other than those won at this Show shall be displayed either on the stalls or in the Cattle Parade.

**Bulls 12 months and over MUST be rung and led with two leads, with one lead attached to the ring.** It is compulsory that all beef females (born before 31 December 2010) must led by a halter and nose clip. Attendants to wear white coats or official breed uniform in the ring please. No commercial or stud logos are to be worn on any apparel in the ring. Feed boxes will not be provided.

**STRAW:** Will be available if ordered and pre-paid for with entry (\$10.00 inc GST) NO GREEN FEED IS AVAILABLE

**All beef cattle must be stalled by 8.45am on the Saturday of the show.**

**CATTLE FRAMES: Space for frames must be booked with entries.**

When there are fewer than three entries in any class only half prize money may be paid. In all classes with five or more entries, the judge shall award four placings. Ribbon only for 4<sup>th</sup> place. The society reserves the right to substitute prize money for product or vouchers

The stewards at the show may provisionally announce point's prizes.

**Points:** 1st 6, 2nd 4, 3rd 2, 4th 1. In the event of a tie a countback will take place.

**Champions and Reserve Champions** will be selected in the following order. First prize winner in all classes shall parade before the judge for his selection of Champion. As soon as the selection is made the second prize winner in the Class in which the Champion is first will parade with the others for Reserve Champion.

**TB POLICY:** All Cattle entered for a showing must be from a herd with C1 or better status or tested clear within previous 12 months and a copy of their TB Test Allocation Certificate must accompany the entry form. TB declaration cards must be carried on day of Show. Due to changes in the TB Regulations, all cattle must have either the official identification tags or the Agri-Quality permit to move stock.

Group owners of an animal may not claim Members' entry rates unless at least one owner is a Member of the Franklin A & P Society.

**JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT TIMES STATED**  
**Judging Commences at 8.45AM SHARP with the Junior Herdperson.**

**Followed at 9.15AM SHARP with the Breed classes.**

#### **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION**

##### **PROTESTS:**

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Where necessary, Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final. It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:** The purpose of our show is to provide our community & visiting competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable day of fun & competition, therefore any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow competitors, stewards, judges or show officials may be asked, at the discretion of the show committee, to leave the showgrounds.

**INSURANCE** Franklin A&P Society will not be held liable for loss or damage to exhibitors/competitor or their property whilst on the grounds. If individual breed numbers are sufficient, a separate breed section may be accommodated at the discretion of the Show Committee. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes in breed rings. Where there are insufficient entries, rings or classes may be combined or deleted. See each section.

**TAGS:** Failure to return these to the designated steward will result in charge of \$10 being levied.

Cattle remaining overnight must have neck ties in addition to halters.

**Exhibitors who wish to arrive on Friday evening should advise the office when placing entries for the show, to facilitate access to stalls.**

Animals may be substituted but only into the same class, the Office to be notified by 5.00pm on the day before competition.

**PRIZE MONEY:** 1<sup>ST</sup> \$20.00, 2<sup>ND</sup> \$15.00 & 3<sup>RD</sup> \$10. Unless otherwise stated

No prize money will be awarded unless the class is completed, as per the conditions of the class.

#### **Malcolm Hutchings- NDCRAS Young Handlers Competition for Dairy and Beef**

This competition includes all Northern District A & P Shows which encompasses Kaitia & Districts to Franklin and includes the Royal Easter Show in Auckland.

Open to all young handlers within New Zealand.

The competitor will be 18 years and under as at the 1<sup>st</sup> October of the current show season.

The competitor may use an animal of any age and the animal does not have to be the property of the handler.

Each competitor may only enter either the beef or dairy class, not both.

To be eligible for the Northern District prize the competitor must have competed at three or more Northern District Shows in these classes this show season.

The winners of the overall competition, one dairy & one beef handler will receive \$250 sponsored by the NDCRAS and a medal awarded by the RAS of NZ.

In the case of draw the prize money will be split accordingly.

**Judging will consider the following areas:**

**Turnout – Appearance of Handler** The dress, footwear and general tidiness needs to be considered. ie clean, strong shoes or boots. No jandals or gumboots.

If a hat is worn it must be worn correctly.

No logos or advertising to be present on any clothing including hats.

For the Royal Easter Show the older group should be wearing a breed uniform or white coat.

**Presentation of Animal** The animal itself is not to be judged however the general presentation is to be

taken into consideration as the youth will have prepared the animal for the ring.

The halter should be clean and fit the animal correctly.

Rope or leather halters allowed. For beef competitors if a show stick is used it must be carried correctly.

#### **Ability of Handling Animal**

To parade and "show of animal"

To stop when asked.

Able to "stand" animal up.

To move on again as requested.

Be aware of different leading styles ie Dairy may lead from the front and beef lead at the shoulder.

#### **Knowledge of Animal**

Breeding – Breed and able to name sire & dam.

Age – Date of birth of animal
