DAIRY CATTLE SECTION **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

CHIEF STEWARD –

Competition is governed by rules of Franklin A&P Society and the guidelines of the Royal Agricultural Society of N.Z. (Inc.), and it shall be deemed as if they have been printed in full in this Schedule. If any exhibitor is not sure of the conditions they should contact the showgrounds office. The Society may publish winners' names.

OWNERSHIP:

All cattle must have been the property of the exhibitor prior to the Show.

All cattle entered in the Purebred Classes must be entered or eligible for entry in the recognised Herd Books of the several breeds. All cattle shall wear a catalogue number when parading in the ring for judging, but no animal shall wear an award ribbon or card awarded in a previous class while in the ring for judging in any special class or for the Championship awards.

A cow, which in the opinion of the supervisor, is unduly overstocked with milk, will not be allowed in the judging ring.

All cattle entered in group or special classes must be entered in open classes.

Only badges and ribbons won at this show may be displayed on stalls or during the cattle parade.

THE LATIMER CUP is awarded in rotation as follows: 2012 Jerseys, 2013 Milking Shorthorns, 2014 Ayrshires, 2015 Holstein – Friesians.

Bulls 12 months and over MUST be rung and led with two leads, with one lead attached to the ring.

Attendants to wear white coats or official breed uniforms in the ring please. No commercial or stud logos are to be worn on any apparel in the ring.

Feed boxes will not be provided.

STRAW: Will be available if ordered and pre-paid for with entry (\$10.00 inc GST) NO GREEN FEED IS AVAILABLE

All dairy cattle must be stalled by 8.30am on Sunday.

When there are fewer than three entries in any class only half the prize money will be paid.

In all classes with five or more entries, the judge shall award four placings.

Points will be awarded in all classes excepting restricted classes as follows:-

1st-10, 2nd - 8, 3rd - 6, 4th - 4.

Points prizes may be provisionally announced by the stewards at the show.

Champions and Reserve Champions will be selected in the following order:

First prize winner in all classes shall parade before the judge for his selection of Champion. As soon as the selection is made the second prize winner in the class

in which the Champion is first will parade with the others for Reserve Champion.

TB POLICY: All cattle entered must be from a herd with C1 status or better, or tested clear within the previous 12 months and have a copy of the certificate accompanying their entry form. TB declaration cards must be carried on the day of the show. Due to changes in the TB Regulations, all cattle must have either the official identification tags or the Agri-Quality permit to move stock.

Tying and taping of cows' teats is not permitted. The Chief Steward has the power to order the removal of the same.

Exhibitors who wish to arrive on Saturday evening should advise the office when placing entries for the show, to facilitate access to stalls.

TAGS: Failure to return these to the designated steward will result in charge of \$10 being levied.

INSURANCE Franklin A&P Society will not be held liable for loss or damage to exhibitors/competitor or their property whilst on the grounds.

PROTESTS:

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Where necessary, Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final. It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

SPORTSMANSHIP: The purpose of our show is to provide our community & visiting competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable day of fun & competition, therefore any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow competitors, stewards, judges or show officials may be asked, at the discretion of the show committee, to leave the showgrounds.

ENTRY FEES: Franklin A & P Society member **\$7.00**, non-member **\$12.00** Unless otherwise stated Group owners of an animal may not claim Members' entry rates unless at least one owner is a Member of the Franklin A & P Society.

CLOSING DATE: Wednesday 18th January 2012.

Late entries accepted upon payment of 50% penalty, up to 5.00pm on the day before competition. No late entries accepted in type & production classes after 1st February. Animals may be substituted but only into the same class. Office to be notified by 5.00pm on the day before competition.

PRIZE MONEY: 1ST \$20.00, 2ND \$15.00 & 3RD \$10. Unless otherwise stated

No prize money will be awarded unless the class is completed, as per the conditions of the class.

PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID OUT BY CHEQUE WITHIN 21 DAYS OF SHOW.

NDCRAS Young Handlers Competition for Dairy and Beef

This competition includes all Northern District A & P Shows which encompasses Kaitaia & Districts to Franklin and includes the Royal Easter Show, in Auckland
Open to all young handlers within New Zealand.
The competitor will be 18 years and under as at the 1st October of the current show season.
The competitor may use an animal of any age and the animal does not have to be the property of the handler.
Each competitor may only enter either the beef or dairy class, not both. To be eligible for the Northern District prize the competitor must have competed at three or more Northern District Shows in these classes this show season. The winners of the overall competition, one dairy & one beef handler will receive \$250 sponsored by the NDCRAS and a medal awarded by the RAS of NZ. In the case of draw the prize money will be split accordingly.

Judging will consider the following areas:

Turnout – Appearance of Handler

The dress, footwear and general tidiness needs to be considered. ie clean, strong shoes or boots. No jandals or gumboots. If a hat is worn it must be worn correctly.

No logos or advertising to be present on any clothing including hats.

For the Royal Easter Show the older group should be wearing a breed uniform or white coat.

Presentation of Animal

The animal itself is not to be judged however the general presentation is to be taken into consideration as the youth will have prepared the animal for the ring. The halter should be clean and fit the animal correctly. Rope or leather halters allowed. For beef competitors if a show stick is used it must be carried correctly.

Ability of Handling Animal

To parade and "show of animal"

To stop when asked.

Able to "stand" animal up.

To move on again as requested.

Be aware of different leading styles ie Dairy may lead from the front and beef lead at the shoulder.

Knowledge of Animal

Breeding – Breed and able to name sire & dam.

Age – Date of birth of animal

Entries may be made on day at showgrounds office by 10.00am

If insufficient entries are received, these classes will parade together but be judged separately
