RULES AND REGULATIONS

CHIEF STEWARD: LORRAINE WORTHINGTON

General Rules and Regulations for the governance and conduct of the Franklin A & P Society shall be those issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ Inc and it shall be deemed as if they had been printed in full in this Schedule.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

COOKING:- only one entry per person per class in cooking unless otherwise specified.

PRESERVES:- Two entries per class per person in preserves but entries must be different varieties eg Sauce – 1 x tomato & 1 x plum

Entries restricted to 2 entries per class in all other classes unless otherwise stated.

Late entries will not be accepted.

- Exhibitor pass issued for 8 eight entries or more.

Exhibits must be bona fide work of entrant & completed within the last two years.

Entrants must supply full name, address and phone number on entry form.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE TICKET with class number on one side and entrants **Number on the back**. If they are to be returned by post, please state on entry form and enclose sufficient stamps.

EXHIBITS may be entered in ONE CLASS ONLY,

An article that has received a **first** prize from this Society in the past is not eligible to enter again.

Washable articles may be washed or otherwise.

All ENTRIES CLOSE 3rd February 2012

FRIDAY 10TH FEBRUARY - Stewards available to receive **non perishable** exhibits in Massey Hall **9am** to **5pm**. Outside those times to Secretary's Office, 9am to 5pm.

FRIDAY 17TH FEBRUARY - Stewards available to receive **perishable** exhibits in Massey Hall **9am** to **4pm**

Cooking, vegetables, flowers, floral art & all children's classes (perishable) will be judged after **4.00pm on Friday**.

The Society reserves the right to verify suitability of exhibits in classes, where appropriate exhibits may be transferred to another class, or disqualified. **Classes may be merged if there are insufficient entries.**

Judges will be accompanied by Stewards only; no visitors to hall during judging.

JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL. If entries not deemed to be up to standard, prizes will not be awarded.

PRIZE MONEY MAY BE COLLECTED FROM THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE FROM 10.00AM ON MONDAY 20th, or during office hours the following week.

All Prize monies over \$20 and Children's total PM exceeding \$10 and family entries will be paid by CHEQUE. All other PM will be cash.

- The Society reserves the right to substitute advertised prize money with either product or vouchers. Where points prizes are awarded, points to count, 1st = 6, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 2.

DISCLAIMER

1) Where necessary, Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final.

2) Due to circumstances beyond our control it may be necessary to make changes to the programme/ prizes/ judges. No correspondence will be entered into.

3) While all care will be taken, the Society will not, under any circumstances be held responsible for loss, damage or mis-delivery of goods exhibited at the Show.

NO EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW BUILDINGS UNTIL 10.AM, MONDAY 20th FEBRUARY.

Show Building will be open until 2.00pm Monday for collection of items. After that time items may be collected from the office.

Due to Health issues all perishable goods eg food & vegetables will be disposed of at the close of the Show.

250 g (8oz) self-raising flour 170 grams (6oz) Honey
117grams (4oz) Butter or Margarine 2 eggs
170 grams (6oz) Sultanas Pinch of salt

Cream butter and honey, beat eggs well and add them alternatively with sifted flour and salt.
Save a little flour and add with the sultanas.
Beat all well but lightly, a little milk can be added if necessary.
Turn in the sultanas and stir well. Bake in a well-buttered circular tin 16cm (6.5") to 18.58cm (7.5") diameter.
Bake for one and a quarter hours in a moderate oven.
