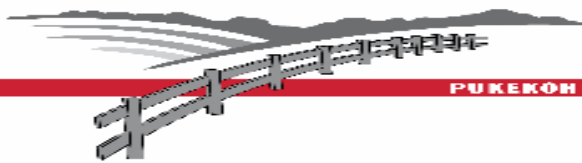

Conditions of Entry:

1. Open to young people who have taken their animal to a school calf club day.
2. All entries in these classes must have been reared under the conditions of the Boys and Girls Agricultural Clubs. Calves are not eligible to enter if suckled on a mother longer than the necessary four days after birth.
3. All entries to be made through the office of the Franklin A & P Society.
4. **Entry Fee \$4.00**
5. Age of entrant to be taken as at 1 November 2011

6. All animals must be penned by 9.30 am.
7. One child - one animal in the Calf Club classes. *The Parader classes allow for one animal per class per competitor.*
8. Competitors shall lead their own animals unless judges grant permission otherwise.
9. Calves must not be clipped or oiled.
10. The Society may combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
11. Adults may assist to wash animals which arrive dirty, but any subsequent grooming or handling must be done only by children.
12. Calves will be judged on Leading, Rearing and Dairy Type or Beef Type.
13. Calves entered must have been born between 1 June and 31 August 2011
14. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st \$6.00, 2nd \$4.00, 3rd \$3.00. or as the committee decides
Ribbons will be awarded to the first three in each class, and Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded.
