## Dairy Goats

This section is Open to all Dairy Goats Registered with the following RAS affiliated Societies:- NZ Dairy Goat Breeders Assoc, Premier Dairy Goats and the Anglo-Nubian Breed Society of NZ.

Must comply with the by-laws of the RAS of NZ for the exhibition of Dairy goats. Also any conditions of the A & P Association running the Show.

### **PROTESTS:**

All protests are to be lodged at the Secretaries office within 30 minutes of the event. Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a \$50.00 cash deposit. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld. Where necessary, Franklin A & P Society will adjudicate in all matters other than judging and such a decision shall be final. It may be necessary to make changes to the programme, prizes or judges because of circumstances beyond our control. No correspondence will be entered into.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:** The purpose of our show is to provide our community & visiting competitors the opportunity to have an enjoyable day of fun & competition, therefore any person or persons who verbally or otherwise abuses fellow competitors, stewards, judges or show officials may be asked, at the discretion of the show committee, to leave the showgrounds

**All Dairy Goats to be penned by 8.00am, in allocated stalls**

**Entry to the showgrounds is through GATE 5 to unload and pen goats**

**In the event that there are three or fewer entries in a class, only half prize money may be paid.**

#### **Herd Register**

- 8001 **Kidded Doe** - in milk under 3 years
- 8002 **Kidded Doe** - in milk 3 yrs & 4 years
- 8003 **Kidded Doe** - in milk 5 years & over

### **Champion Herd Register Doe & Reserve Champion Herd Register Doe**

- 8004 **Herd Register Champion Challenge Doe** – open to Does that have gained their GCH Prefix, or are pending the award.

#### **Champion Challenge Doe**

To be selected from the winner of class 8004 and the Champion Herd Register Doe, NO award to be made if there is no competition.

#### **Associated Records**

- 8005 **Kidded Doe** - in milk under 3 yrs
- 8006 **Kidded Doe** - in milk 3 yrs & 4 years
- 8007 **Kidded Doe** - in milk 5 years & over

### **Champion Associated Record Doe & Reserve Champion Associated Record Doe**

- 8008 **Associated Record Grand Champion Age Class** – open to does that have gained their GCH Prefix, or are pending the award

#### **Champion Challenge Doe**

To be selected from the winner of class 8008 and the Champion Associated Record Doe, NO award to be made if there is no competition

### **Special Classes**

- 8009 **Senior Progeny** -2 daughters in milk of same sire, different dams. Names of Sire & Dam to be stated at time of entry.
- 8010 **Herd Register** - Type & Production - rules as per NZDGBA. Details of Herd Test production to be supplied with entries or to the steward on the day.
- 8011 **Associated Record** - Type & Production - rules as per NZDGBA. Details of Herd Test production to be supplied with entries or to the steward on the day.
- 8012 **Herd Register Best Udder** - open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged full & then again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. (Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for the empty udder judging)
- 8013 **Associated Record Best Udder**- conditions as above

### **Junior Showmanship Classes**

- 8014 **Junior Showmanship** - 15yrs & under. Exhibitors age to be stated on entry form. To be judged on the exhibitor's ability to lead, place, turn, stop and start their goat and answer 2 questions. Show preparation and appearance of exhibitor and goat taken into account. Exhibitors age to be included on the entry form.

- 8015 **Advanced Gold Junior Showmanship**
- 8016 **Junior Herdperson-** 15years & up to 25yrs. Showing an adult goat. To be judged on presentation, the knowledge of the anatomy of the animal, the handling & health of the adult goat. Goat does not necessarily have to belong to the exhibitor.

### **Standard Age Classes - Junior Does**

#### **Herd Register**

- 8017 **Herd Register Maiden Doe or Goatling -** 12mths & under 30mths, includes maiden milking & springing does
- 8018 **Herd Register Doe Kid -** born on or before 31 August 2011
- 8019 **Herd Register Doe Kid -** born after 31 August 2011

#### **Champion Herd Register Junior Doe & Reserve Champion Herd Register Junior Doe**

#### **Associated Records – Crossbred, Appendix & Recorded**

- 8020 **Maiden Doe or Goatling -**12mths & under 30mths that has never borne a kid, including milking maiden & springing does
- 8021 **Maiden Doe Kid -** born on or before 31 August 2011
- 8022 **Maiden Doe Kid -** born after 31 August 2011

#### **Champion Associated Record Junior Doe & Reserve Champion Associated Record Junior Doe**

### **Junior Special Classes**

- 8023 **Junior Progeny Group-** 2 daughters under 30mths that have not borne a kid, by the same sire but different dams. Names of Sire & Dam to be stated at time of entry.

### **Buck Classes**

#### **Herd Register**

- 8024 **Buck Kid -** under 12 months
- 8025 **Buckling-** 12months & under 2 yrs
- 8026 **Buck -** 2 yrs & over

#### **Champion Buck & Reserve Champion Buck**

- 8027 **Grand Champion Age - Bucks –** open to buck that have gained their GCH Prefix, or are pending the award

#### **Champion Challenge Buck**

To be selected from the winner of class 8027 and the Champion Buck, NO award to be made if there is no competition

### **Supreme Champion Dairy Goat**

**Breed Certificates- HR Doe HR Buck**

#### **Notes**

#### **Type & Production 1**

Open to all does on Official Herd Test. The date of birth of each entry is to be stated. All entries must have kidded within two years prior to the date of the show, and must be in-milk at the time of judging. The lactation for which production points shall be awarded to be the best of the last two completed lactations. The lactation period is not to exceed 305 days.

Lactation details Type and Production forms must be supplied to the Show Steward by the exhibitor at penning time, to enable the steward to check calculations. Lactation details must be either original Herd Test forms or photocopies of same. The competition is to be based on an allocation of 100 points for production, and 100 points for type

#### **Production Points**

Exhibitors may choose either option 1 or option 2

#### **Option 1**

Each doe to be credited on the basis of 1 point of each 22 litres of milk or part thereof OVER STANDARD FOR AGE, with a maximum of 50 points. Each doe shall also be credited with 4 points for every 4.54 kilograms of fat OVER HER STANDARD FOR AGE, with a maximum of 50 points.

#### **Option 2**

Each doe to be credited with double the milk points as calculated in option 1 with a maximum of 100 points; no fat points to be claimed.

Production points shall be calculated by the Steward prior to judging.

#### **Type Points**

Each doe to be scored out of 100 points for type. When more than one judge is officiating the points awarded by each are to be averaged.

#### **Best Udder Classes**

Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder and to be totalled to determine the prize winners. (Does must be stripped out prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

**NZDGBA Rule 24** - Show Awards, where it relates to the Grand Champion class for Champion Challenge, is as follows: Premier Dairy Goats have identical rules on the award.

#### **GRAND CHAMPION (GCH) – prefix**

To be awarded to any doe who gains 6 Champion wins. Does must have competition in the Championship Class or have competition in and win the Champion Challenge class.

To be awarded to any Herd Register buck or buckling who gains 6 Champion wins. Bucks must have competition in the Championship Class or have competition in and win the Champion Challenge class. (For Herd Register animals, each

Champion win must be accompanied by a Breed Award at the same show, unless eligible for a Breed Champion).

**ADVANCED GRAND CHAMPION (AGC) – prefix**

To be awarded to any Grand Champion doe or buck which gains 10 Champion Challenge wins.

**ENTRIES CLOSE: Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2012**

**PRIZE MONEY:** 1st \$12; 2nd \$8 3rd \$5  
Unless otherwise stated.

**In the event that there are three or fewer entries in a class, only half prize money may be paid.**

**All prize money will be paid by cheque post show- any queries must be lodged within three weeks of the shows completion. Prizes not claimed within 2 months of the show will be deemed invalid.**

**Conditions:**

1. Must comply with the by-laws of the RAS of NZ for the exhibition of Boer goats. Also any conditions of the A & P Association running the Show.
2. All animals must be free of external parasites and be cleanly presented to show condition.
3. All show entries will be judged against the current **Breed Standard**.
4. All goats must have legible tattoo or ear tag consistent with its registration certificate.
5. No animal will be admitted into the show ring unless duly entered, which requires the completion of the entry form. Not just a notation of an animal.
6. The Franklin A & P committee reserves the right to withdraw any class for which there are insufficient entries.
7. Does over 24 months to have reared a kid in 2010.
8. Kids to be included in Championship judging.
9. Champions will be selected from the winners of the eligible classes. The second placed animal from the class in which the champion was selected must be paraded with the other eligible class winners for selection of Reserve Champion.

10. No Goats to be uplifted prior to 4.00pm.
